(please dispose in trash)



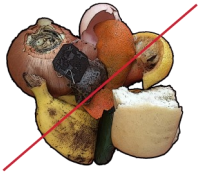
No Hoses or Tangles

(drain, rinse and compost instead)

No Clothes or Shoes
(donate or drop-off where available)
